History of the church



The exact date of the building of All Saints' Waterden is not known but it is believed to be at least 1000 years old and is almost certainly of Anglo-Saxon origin. The village of Waterden disappeared in late medieval times, leaving the Church on its own in the middle of fields, accompanied only by a rectory put up in the Victorian era and Waterden Farm close by.

The architecture has changed over the centuries. Along with its Anglo-Saxon origins, the church has Norman elements and was once a much larger building, as shown by the stump of a tower and a lost south aisle. In 1895 a great gale did a lot of damage and resulted in a major restoration project, a new roof and a bell cupola.

The church fell into disrepair and was saved and restored in the early 1970s before it finally became attached to South Creake in 1984 as the second church in the parish along with St Mary's South Creake.

The church today

The church is never locked. It remains a consecrated building and has never been made redundant. It is always open to visitors and holds eight services a year, including a well-attended candlelit Carol Service on Christmas Eve. Evensong is held on six summer evenings and there is a patronal festival Eucharist on the 1st of November.

In addition, the church is available for baptisms, weddings and funerals.
